

Ephesians 3

1. ref According to Ephesians chapter 3 verse 1, What (am) I?
3:1 The prisoner of Christ Jesus for the sake of you Gentiles
2. The mystery of Christ was not made known to men in other generations how?
3:4 As it has now been revealed by the Spirit to God's holy apostles and prophets
3. ref According to Ephesians chapter 3 verse 6, This mystery is what?
3:6 That through the gospel the Gentiles are fellow heirs, fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus
4. I became a servant of this gospel how?
3:7 By the gift of God's grace, given me through the working of His power
5. ref According to Ephesians chapter 3 verse 8, What grace was given me?
3:8 This: to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, and to illuminate for everyone the stewardship of this mystery
6. The manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms, according to what?
3:10 The eternal purpose that He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord
7. So I ask you not to be discouraged because of what?
3:13 My sufferings for you, which are your glory
8. For this reason I bow my knees before whom?
3:14 The Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name
9. ref According to Ephesians chapter 3 verse 16, I ask what?
3:16 That out of the riches of His glory He may strengthen you with power through His Spirit in your inner being
10. You will have power, together with all the saints, to comprehend what?
3:18 The length and width and height and depth of the love of Christ
11. How may you be filled?
3:19 With all the fullness of God
12. To Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, when?
3:21 Forever and ever

Ephesians 4

1. I urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling you have received: how?
4:1 With all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, and with diligence to preserve the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace
2. There is one body and one Spirit, how?
4:4 Just as you were called to one hope when you were called
3. How has grace been given to each one of us?
4:7 According to the measure of the gift of Christ
4. ref According to Ephesians chapter 4 verse 8, This is what?
4:8 Why it says: "When He ascended on high, He led captives away, and gave gifts to men."
5. It was He who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, why?
4:11 To equip the saints for works of ministry and to build up the body of Christ
6. We all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God, as we mature to what?
4:13 The full measure of the stature of Christ
7. We will no longer be infants, tossed about by the waves and carried around by what?
4:14 Every wind of teaching and by the clever cunning of men in their deceitful scheming
8. Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into whom?
4:15 Christ Himself, who is the head
9. The whole body, fitted and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love how?
4:16 Through the work of each individual part
10. ref According to Ephesians chapter 4 verse 17, I tell you what?
4:17 That you must no longer walk as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking
11. Why are they darkened in their understanding and alienated from the life of God?
4:18 Because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardness of their hearts

12. They have given themselves over to sensuality for what?
4:19 The practice of every kind of impurity, with a craving for more
13. Surely you heard of Him and were taught in Him how?
4:21 In keeping with the truth that is in Jesus
14. The new self (is) created to be like God in what?
4:24 True righteousness and holiness
15. ref According to Ephesians chapter 4 verse 25, We are what?
4:25 All members of one another
16. Why must he who has been stealing steal no longer, but must work, doing good with his own hands?
4:28 That he may have something to share with the one in need
17. And do not grieve whom?
4:30 The Holy Spirit of God, in whom you were sealed for the day of redemption
18. Get rid of what?
4:31 All bitterness, rage and anger, outcry and slander, along with every form of malice
19. ref According to Ephesians chapter 4 verse 32, Be what?
4:32 Kind and tenderhearted to one another

Ephesians 5

1. And walk in love, how?
5:2 Just as Christ loved us and gave Himself up for us as a fragrant sacrificial offering to God
2. But among you, as is proper among the saints, there must not be even a hint of what?
5:3 Sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed
3. Of what can you be sure?
5:5 This: No immoral, impure, or greedy person (that is, an idolater), has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God
4. For the fruit of the light consists in what?
5:9 All goodness, righteousness, and truth
5. Have no fellowship with what?
5:11 The fruitless deeds of darkness
6. Pay careful attention, then, to how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, redeeming the time, why?
5:15 Because the days are evil
7. Sing and make music in your hearts to the Lord, always giving thanks to God the Father for everything how?
5:19 In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ
8. ref According to Ephesians chapter 5 verse 21, Submit to whom?
5:21 One another
9. For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of whom?
5:23 The church, His body, of which He is the Savior
10. As the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to whom?
5:24 Their husbands
11. Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her to sanctify her, cleansing her how?
5:25 By the washing with water through the word
12. ref According to Ephesians chapter 5 verse 28, Who loves himself?
5:28 He who loves his wife
13. For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to whom?
5:31 His wife
14. This mystery is profound, but I am speaking about whom?
5:32 Christ and the church
