2:19 That I also may be cheered when I learn how you are doing
13. ref According to Philippians chapter 2 verse 22, You know what?
2:22 Timothy's proven worth, that as a child with his father he has served with me to advance the gospel
14. ref According to Philippians chapter 2 verse 23, I hope what?
2:23 To send him as soon as I see what happens with me
15. I thought what necessary?
2:25 To send back to you Epaphroditus, my brother, fellow worker, and fellow soldier, who is also your messenger and minister to my needs
16. ref According to Philippians chapter 2 verse 26, You heard what?
2:26 He was ill
17. Therefore I am all the more eager to send him, why?
2:28 So that when you see him again you may rejoice, and I may be less anxious
18. ref According to Philippians chapter 2, Honor whom?
2:29 Men like him (Epaphroditus)

1. What is no trouble for me?
3:1 To write the same things to you again
2. Watch out for whom?
3:2 Those dogs, those workers of evil, those mutilators of the flesh!
3. What if anyone else thinks he has grounds for confidence in the flesh?
3:4 I have more
4. I count what as loss for the sake of Christ?
3:7 Whatever was gain to me
5. I count all things as loss compared to what?
3:8 The surpassing excellence of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord
6. I may be found in Him, not having what?
3:9 My own righteousness from the law
7. ref According to Philippians chapter 3, I want what?
3:10 To know Christ and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, and so, somehow, to attain to the resurrection from the dead
