

Colossians 2

1. Continue to walk in Him how?  
2:6 Just as you have received Christ Jesus as Lord / Rooted and built up in Him, established in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness
2. ref According to Colossians chapter 2 verse 8, See to it that what?  
2:8 No one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deception
3. And having been buried with Him in baptism, you were raised with Him through what?  
2:12 Your faith in the power of God, who raised Him from the dead
4. ref According to Colossians chapter 2 verse 13, You were dead in what?  
2:13 Your trespasses and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature
5. God made you alive with Christ when?  
2:13 When you were dead in your trespasses and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature
6. Therefore let no one judge you by what?  
2:16 What you eat or drink, or with regard to a feast, a New Moon, or a Sabbath
7. Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you how?  
2:18 With speculation about what he has seen
8. He has lost connection to whom?  
2:19 The head, from whom the whole body, supported and knit together by its joints and ligaments, grows as God causes it to grow
9. What if you have died with Christ to the spiritual forces of the world?  
2:20 Why, as though you still belonged to the world, do you submit to its regulations: "Do not handle, do not taste, do not touch!"?
10. Why will these all perish with use?  
2:22 Because they are based on human commands and teachings
11. Such restrictions indeed have an appearance of wisdom, with what?  
2:23 Their self-prescribed worship, their false humility, and their harsh treatment of the body

Colossians 3

1. Therefore, since you have been raised with Christ, strive for the things where?  
3:1 Above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God
2. When will you also appear with Him in glory?  
3:4 When Christ, who is your life, appears
3. Put to death, therefore, what?  
3:5 The components of your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires, and greed, which is idolatry
4. Do not lie to one another, why?  
3:9 Since you have taken off the old self with its practices, and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator
5. You have put on what?  
3:10 The new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator
6. Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, clothe yourselves with what?  
3:12 Hearts of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience
7. And over all these virtues put on what?  
3:14 Love, which is the bond of perfect unity
8. Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, why?  
3:15 For to this you were called as members of one body
9. Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you when?  
3:16 As you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God
10. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do it all how?  
3:17 In the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him
11. ref According to Colossians chapter 3, Wives, submit to your husbands, how?  
3:18 As is fitting in the Lord
12. Husbands, love your wives and do not be what?  
3:19 Harsh with them
13. Obey your parents in everything, why?  
3:20 For this is pleasing to the Lord
14. Why do not provoke your children?  
3:21 So they will not become discouraged

15. Obey your earthly masters in everything, how?  
3:22 Not only to please them while they are watching, but with sincerity of heart and fear of the Lord
16. Work at it with your whole being, for the Lord and not for men, why?  
3:23 Because you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as your reward
17. ref According to Colossians chapter 3 verse 24, You know what?  
3:24 That you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as your reward

Colossians 4

1. Supply your slaves with what is right and fair, why?  
4:1 Since you know that you also have a Master in heaven
2. You pray also for us what?  
4:3 That God may open to us a door for the word, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains
3. Why let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt?  
4:6 So that you may know how to answer everyone
4. ref According to Colossians chapter 4 verse 7, He is what?  
4:7 A beloved brother, a faithful minister, and a fellow servant in the Lord
5. With him I am sending whom?  
4:9 Onesimus, our faithful and beloved brother, who is one of you
6. ref According to Colossians chapter 4 verse 10, Who sends you greetings?  
4:10 My fellow prisoner Aristarchus, as does Mark the cousin of Barnabas
7. Why is he always wrestling in prayer for you?  
4:12 So that you may stand mature and fully assured in the full will of God
8. ref According to Colossians chapter 4, I testify what?  
4:13 That he goes to great pains for you and for those at Laodicea and Hierapolis
9. After this letter has been read among you, make sure that what?  
4:16 It is also read in the church of the Laodiceans, and that you in turn read the letter from Laodicea

Philemon 1

1. I always thank my God, remembering you in my prayers, why?  
1:4 Because I hear about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints
2. ref According to Philemon chapter 1 verse 9, I am what?  
1:9 Aged, and a prisoner of Christ Jesus as well
3. Formerly he was useless to you, but now he has become what?  
1:11 Useful both to you and to me
4. Why would I have liked to keep him with me?  
1:13 So that on your behalf he could minister to me in my chains for the gospel
5. Why did I not want to do anything without your consent?  
1:14 So that your goodness will not be out of compulsion, but by your own free will
6. Why was he separated from you for a while?  
1:15 So that you might have him back for good--no longer as a slave, but better than a slave, as a beloved brother
7. Confident of your obedience, I write to you, knowing what?  
1:21 That you will do even more than I ask
8. ref According to Philemon chapter 1, Who sends you greetings?  
1:23 Epaphras, my fellow prisoner in Christ Jesus, as do Mark, Aristarchus, Demas, and Luke, my fellow workers
