

Galatians 1

1. To the churches of Galatia: Grace and peace (be) to you from whom?
1:2 God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
2. I am amazed how quickly you are deserting whom?
1:6 The One who called you by the grace of Christ
3. As we have said before, so now I say again: what?
1:9 If anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to the one you received, let him be under a curse!
4. For I certify to you, brothers, what?
1:11 That the gospel I preached was not devised by man
5. What have you heard of my former way of life in Judaism?
1:13 How severely I persecuted the church of God and tried to destroy it
6. Who was pleased to reveal His Son in me?
1:15 God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me His grace
7. When did I not rush to consult with flesh and blood?
1:16 When God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me by His grace, was pleased to reveal His Son in me so that I might preach Him among the Gentiles
8. I assure you before God what?
1:20 That what I am writing to you is no lie
9. ref According to Galatians chapter 1 verse 21, I went where?
1:21 To the regions of Syria and Cilicia
10. They only heard what account?
1:23 "The man who formerly persecuted us is now preaching the faith he once tried to destroy."

Galatians 2

1. I spoke privately to those recognized as leaders, why?
2:2 For fear that I was running or had already run in vain
2. I went in response to a revelation and set before them what?
2:2 The gospel that I preach among the Gentiles
3. This issue arose why?
2:4 Because some false brothers had come in under false pretenses to spy on our freedom in Christ Jesus, in order to enslave us
4. We did not give in to them for what?
2:5 A moment
5. On the contrary, they saw what?
2:7 That I had been entrusted to preach the gospel to the uncircumcised, just as Peter had been to the circumcised
6. Who was also at work in my apostleship to the Gentiles?
2:8 The One who was at work in Peter's apostleship to the circumcised
7. James, Cephas, and John gave me and Barnabas the right hand of fellowship, why?
2:9 So that we should go to the Gentiles, and they to the circumcised
8. He used to eat with the Gentiles when?
2:12 Before certain men came from James
9. We who are Jews by birth and not Gentile "sinners" know what?
2:15 That a man is not justified by works of the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ
10. Why have we, too, believed in Christ Jesus?
2:16 That we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified
11. The life I live in the body, I live by what?
2:20 Faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me
12. Why do I not set aside the grace of God?
2:21 For if righteousness comes through the law, Christ died for nothing

Galatians 3

1. What would I like to learn from you?
3:2 Just one thing: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law, or by hearing with faith?
2. ref According to Galatians chapter 3 verse 7, Understand what?
3:7 That those who have faith are sons of Abraham
3. ref According to Galatians chapter 3 verse 10, What is written?
3:10 "Cursed is everyone who does not continue to do everything written in the Book of the Law."
4. ref According to Galatians chapter 3 verse 11, What is clear?
3:11 That no one is justified before God by the law
5. ref According to Galatians chapter 3 verse 13, What is written?
3:13 "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."

6. The blessing promised to Abraham would come to the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, why?
3:14 So that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit
7. The law that came 430 years later does not revoke what?
3:17 The covenant previously established by God
8. Why then was the law given?
3:19 It was added because of transgressions, until the arrival of the seed to whom the promise referred
9. What if a law had been given that could impart life?
3:21 Then righteousness would certainly have come from the law
10. The Scripture pronounces all things confined by sin, why?
3:22 So that by faith in Jesus Christ the promise might be given to those who believe
11. The law became our guardian to lead us to Christ, why?
3:24 That we might be justified by faith
12. Who have clothed yourselves with Christ?
3:27 All of you who were baptized into Christ
13. ref According to Galatians chapter 3 verse 28, You are what?
3:28 All one in Christ Jesus

Galatians 4

1. What am I saying?
4:1 That as long as the heir is a child, he is no different from a slave, although he is the owner of everything
2. God sent His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, why?
4:4 To redeem those under the law, that we might receive our adoption as sons
3. Formerly, when you did not know God, you were slaves to whom?
4:8 Those who by nature are not gods
4. ref According to Galatians chapter 4 verse 13, You know what?
4:13 That it was because of an illness that I first preached the gospel to you
5. What if it were possible?
4:15 You would have torn out your eyes and given them to me
6. ref According to Galatians chapter 4 verse 22, What is written?
4:22 That Abraham had two sons, one by the slave woman and the other by the free woman
7. These things serve as illustrations, why?
4:24 For the women represent two covenants
8. Hagar corresponds to the present-day Jerusalem, why?
4:25 Because she is in slavery with her children
9. ref According to Galatians chapter 4 verse 27, What is written?
4:27 "Rejoice, O barren woman, who bears no children; break forth and cry aloud, you who have never travailed; because more are the children of the desolate woman than of her who has a husband."
10. But what does the Scripture say?
4:30 "Expel the slave woman and her son, for the slave woman's son will never share in the inheritance with the free woman's son."
