Acts 3

1. And a man who was lame from birth was being carried to what?  
3:2 The temple gate called Beautiful
2. sit Who, To whom, Result: "Silver or gold I do not have, but what I have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, get up and walk!"  
3:6 \* Peter \* A man who was lame from birth \* Taking him by the right hand, Peter helped him up, and at once the man's feet and ankles were made strong.
3. When all the people saw him walking and praising God, they recognized him as whom?  
3:9 The man who used to sit begging at the Beautiful Gate of the temple

4:1 While Peter and John were speaking to the people
2. sit Who, To whom, When: "By what power or what name did you do this?"  
4:7 \* The rulers, elders, and scribes \* Peter and John \* The next day
3. Then let what be known to all of you and to all the people of Israel?  
4:10 This: It is by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified but whom God raised from the dead, that this man stands before you healed
4. ref According to Acts chapter 4 verse 11, Who is Jesus?  
4:11 'The stone you builders rejected, which has become the cornerstone.'
5. Salvation exists in no one else, why?  
4:12 For there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved
6. What is clear to everyone living in Jerusalem?  
4:16 That a remarkable miracle has occurred through them
7. Why must we warn them not to speak to anyone in this name?  
4:17 To keep this message from spreading any further among the people
8. For we cannot stop speaking about what?  
4:20 What we have seen and heard
9. Sovereign Lord, You made what?  
4:24 The heaven and the earth and the sea and everything in them
10. The kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers gather together against whom?  
4:26 The Lord and against His Anointed One
11. Consider their threats, and enable Your servants to speak Your word how?  
4:29 With complete boldness

12. Why were there no needy ones among them?  
4:34 Because those who owned lands or houses would sell their property,  
bring the proceeds from the sales, and lay them at the apostles' feet  
for distribution to anyone as he had need
