1:2 After giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles He had chosen
2. After His suffering, He presented Himself to them with what?
1:3 Many convincing proofs that He was alive
3. Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for what?
1:4 The gift the Father promised, which you have heard Me discuss
4. sit Who, to whom, IRepTW: "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by His own authority.
1:7 * Jesus * The apostles He had chosen * "Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?"

6. sit Who, To whom, How: "Men of Judea and all who dwell in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and listen carefully to my words.
2:14 * Peter * The crowd * Stood up with the Eleven, lifted up his voice
7. When will the sun be turned to darkness, and the moon to blood?
2:20 Before the coming of the great and glorious Day of the Lord
8. ref According to Acts chapter 2 verse 21, Who will be saved?
2:21 Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord
9. ref According to Acts chapter 2 verse 24, God raised Him from the dead, releasing Him from the agony of death, why?
2:24 Because it was impossible for Him to be held in its clutches
10. Why will my body also dwell in hope?
2:26 Because You will not abandon my soul to Hades, nor will You let Your Holy One see decay
11. But he was a prophet and knew what?
2:30 That God had promised him on oath that He would place one of his descendants on his throne
12. For David did not ascend into heaven, but he himself says: what?
2:34 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet."'
13. Therefore let all Israel know with certainty what?
2:36 That God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ

14. sit Who, To whom, Response: "Brothers, what shall we do?"
2:37 * The people * Peter and the other apostles * Peter replied,
"Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ
for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the
Holy Spirit.
15. With many other words he testified, and he urged them, what?
2:40 "Be saved from this corrupt generation."
16. They devoted themselves to what?
2:42 The apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of
bread and to prayer
17. They continued to break bread from house to house how?
2:46 Sharing their meals with gladness and sincerity of heart, praising
God and enjoying the favor of all the people

made strong.
4. When all the people saw him walking and praising God, they recognized him as
whom?
3:9 The man who used to sit begging at the Beautiful Gate of the temple
5. And they were filled with wonder and amazement at what?
3:10 What had happened to him
6. sit Who, To whom, Where: "Men of Israel, why are you surprised by this? Why do you
stare at us as if by our own power or godliness we had made this man walk?"
3:12 * Peter * The people / All the people * The walkway called
Solomon's Colonnade
7. Who has glorified His servant Jesus?
3:13 The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers
8. How has this man whom you see and know been made strong?
3:16 By faith in the name of Jesus
9. And now, brothers, I know what?
3:17 That you acted in ignorance, as did your leaders
10. What has God fulfilled in this way?
3:18 What He foretold through all the prophets, saying that His Christ
would suffer
11. Repent, then, and turn back, why?
3:19 So that your sins may be wiped away, that times of refreshing may
come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Jesus, the
Christ, who has been appointed for you
12. Heaven must take Him in until the time comes for what?
3:21 The restoration of all things, which God announced long ago through
His holy prophets
13. For Moses said, what?
3:22 'The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from
among your brothers.
14. Who have proclaimed these days?
3:24 All the prophets from Samuel on, as many as have spoken
15. ref According to Acts chapter 3 verse 25, You are what?
3:25 Sons of the prophets and of the covenant God made with your fathers
16. When God raised up His Servant, He sent Him first to you to bless you how?
3:26 By turning each of you from your wicked ways
