1. 1:2 After giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles He had chosen
2. 1:3 Many convincing proofs that He was alive
3. 1:4 The gift the Father promised, which you have heard Me discuss
4. 1:7 \* Jesus \* The apostles He had chosen \* "Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?"
5. 1:8 In Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth
6. 1:11 This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven
7. 1:13 They: Peter and John, James and Andrew, Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew and Matthew, James son of Alphaeus, Simon the Zealot, and Judas son of James
8. 1:14 The women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers
9. 1:16 Judas, who became a guide for those who arrested Jesus
