2:20 Before the coming of the great and glorious Day of the Lord
8. ref According to Acts chapter 2, Who will be saved?
2:21 Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord
9. Why will my body also dwell in hope?
2:26 Because You will not abandon my soul to Hades, nor will You let Your Holy One see decay
10. But he was a prophet and knew what?
2:30 That God had promised him on oath that He would place one of his descendants on his throne

2:36 That God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ
12. sit Who, To whom, Response: "Brothers, what shall we do?"
2:37 * The people * Peter and the other apostles * Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
