## 1 Corinthians 6

1. 6:15 The members of Christ.
2. 6:18 All other sins a man commits are outside his body, but he who sins sexually sins against his own body.
3. 6:20,19 You are not your own; you were bought at a price.

## 1 Corinthians 7

## 1 Corinthians 8

1. 8:4 We know that an idol is nothing at all in the world and that there is no God but one.
2. 8:5-6 Yet for us there is but one God, the Father, from whom all things came and for whom we live; and there is but one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things came and through whom we live.
3. 8:9 That the exercise of your freedom does not become a stumbling block to the weak.
4. 8:13 I will never eat meat again, so that I will not cause him to fall.

## 1 Corinthians 9

1. 9:9 Do not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain.
2. 9:11 Is it too much if we reap a material harvest from you.
3. 9:12 Hinder the gospel of Christ.
4. 9:14,13 In the same way that those who work in the temple get their food from the temple, and those who serve at the altar share in what is offered at the altar.
5. 9:16 For I am compelled to preach.
6. 9:19 To win as many as possible.
7. 9:22 So that by all possible means I might save some.
8. 9:24 In such a way as to get the prize.
9. 9:27 So that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified for the prize.

## 1 Corinthians 10

1. 10:6 To keep us from setting our hearts on evil things as they did.
2. 10:8,1 Twenty-three thousand of our forefathers who committed sexual immorality (them).
3. 10:9,1 Some of our forefathers who tested the Lord (them).
4. 10:11 Us, on whom the fulfillment of the ages has come.
5. 10:12 Be careful that you don't fall.
6. 10:13 He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.
7. 10:21 You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons too; you cannot have a part in both the Lord's table and the table of demons.
8. 10:23 Not everything is beneficial, not everything is constructive.
9. 10:25-26 For, "The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it".
10. 10:27 Eat whatever is put before you without raising questions of conscience.
11. 10:33 For I am not seeking my own good but the good of many, so that they may be saved.

## 1 Corinthians 11
