1 Corinthians 1:1 - 1 Corinthians 2:16

1 Corinthians 1

1. 1:5 In every way--in all your speaking and in all your knowledge.
2. 1:7 As you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed.
3. 1:8 So that you will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.
4. 1:10 That all of you agree with one another so that there may be no divisions among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought.
5. 1:11 That there are quarrels among you.
6. 1:14-15 So no one can say that you were baptized into my name.
7. 1:17 Lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.
8. 1:18 Foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.
9. 1:19 "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise; the intelligence of the intelligent I will frustrate".
10. 1:20 The wisdom of the world.
11. 1:21 Through the foolishness of what was preached.
12. 1:23 Christ crucified: a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles.
13. 1:25 The foolishness of God.
14. 1:26 Not many of you were wise by human standards; not many were influential; not many were of noble birth.
15. 1:29,28 He chose the lowly things of the world and the despised things and the things that are not to nullify the things that are.
16. 1:31,30 It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God--that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption (therefore).

1 Corinthians 2

1. 2:2,1 For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified.
2. 2:3 In weakness and fear, and with much trembling.
3. 2:4-5 So that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power.
4. 2:7 God's secret wisdom, a wisdom that has been hidden and that God destined for our glory before time began.
5. 2:9 What God has prepared for those who love him.
6. 2:10 All things, even the deep things of God.
7. 2:12 That we may understand what God has freely given us.
8. 2:14 For they are foolishness to him.
9. 2:16 The mind of Christ.
