1 Corinthians 14

1. 14:3 Their edification, encouragement, and comfort
2. 14:5 He who prophesies is greater than one who speaks in tongues, unless he interprets, so that the church may be edified
3. 14:15 I will pray with my spirit, but I will also pray with my mind. I will sing with my spirit, but I will also sing with my mind
4. 14:19 Five coherent words to instruct others
5. 14:20 Infants in regard to evil, mature in your thinking
6. 14:21 "By strange tongues and foreign lips I will speak to this people, but even then they will not listen to Me, says the Lord."
7. 14:24 He will be convicted and called to account by all, and the secrets of his heart will be revealed
8. 14:26 When you come together, everyone has a psalm or a teaching, a revelation, a tongue, or an interpretation. All of these must be done to build up the church

1 Corinthians 15

1. 15:1 The gospel I preached to you, which you received, and in which you stand firm
2. 15:2 You hold firmly to the word I preached to you
3. 15:3 For our sins
4. 15:6 More than five hundred brothers, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep
5. 15:8 Me also
6. 15:9 Because I persecuted the church of God
7. 15:12 How can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?
8. 15:14 Our preaching is worthless, and so is your faith
9. 15:15 For we have testified about God that He raised Christ from the dead, but He did not raise Him if in fact the dead are not raised
10. 15:16 Then not even Christ has been raised
11. 15:17 Your faith is futile; you are still in your sins
12. 15:19 We are to be pitied more than all men
13. 15:24 All dominion, authority, and power
