1 Corinthians 14

- 1. 14:3 Their edification, encouragement, and comfort
- 2. 14:5 He who prophesies is greater than one who speaks in tongues, unless he interprets, so that the church may be edified
- 3. 14:15 I will pray with my spirit, but I will also pray with my mind. I will sing with my spirit, but I will also sing with my mind
