2 Corinthians 5

1. 5:1 That if the earthly tent we live in is dismantled, we have a building from God, an eternal house in heaven, not built by human hands
2. 5:2 Our heavenly dwelling
3. 5:4 Because we do not wish to be unclothed but clothed, so that our mortality may be swallowed up by life
4. 5:5 A pledge of what is to come
5. 5:6 That while we are at home in the body, we are away from the Lord
6. 5:7 Faith
7. 5:8 Away from the body and at home with the Lord
8. 5:9 Away from it
9. 5:10 That each one may receive his due for the things done in the body, whether good or bad
10. 5:11 What it means to fear the Lord
11. 5:12 So that you can answer those who take pride in appearances rather than in the heart
12. 5:14 Because we are convinced that One died for all, therefore all died
13. 5:15 That those who live should no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died for them and was raised again
