## Galatians 1

1. 1:4-5 To rescue us from this present evil age.
2. 1:6,7 That you are so quickly deserting the one who called you by the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel--which is really no gospel at all.
3. 1:8 Let him be eternally condemned!.
4. 1:10 I would not be a servant of Christ.
5. 1:12,11 By revelation from Jesus Christ.
6. 1:13 My previous way of life in Judaism, how intensely I persecuted the church of God and tried to destroy it.
7. 1:15-16 So that I might preach him among the Gentiles.
8. 1:18,17 Three years after I went into Arabia and later returned to Damascus.
9. 1:20 That what I am writing you is no lie.
10. 1:23 The faith he once tried to destroy.

## Galatians 2

1. 2:4 To spy on the freedom we have in Christ Jesus and to make us slaves.
2. 2:5 So that the truth of the gospel might remain with you.
3. 2:7 That I had been entrusted with the task of preaching the gospel to the Gentiles, just as Peter had been to the Jews.
4. 2:10 The poor.
5. 2:12 Because he was afraid of those who belonged to the circumcision group.
6. 2:14 "You are a Jew, yet you live like a Gentile and not like a Jew. How is it then, that you force Gentiles to follow Jewish customs?".
7. 2:16 That we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by observing the law, because by observing the law no one will be justified.
8. 2:20 By faith in the Son of God who loved me and gave himself for me.
9. 2:21 Christ died for nothing.

## Galatians 3

1. 3:1 As crucified.
2. 3:3 After beginning with the Spirit.
3. 3:7,6 Abraham believed God and it was credited to him as righteousness.
4. 3:9,8 The Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you".
5. 3:10 For it is written: "Cursed is everyone who does not continue to do everything written in the Book of the Law".
6. 3:13 By becoming a curse for us.
7. 3:17 It does not set aside the covenant previously established by God.
8. 3:19 It was added because of transgressions until the Seed to whom the promise referred had come.
9. 3:21 Then righteousness would certainly have come by the law.
10. 3:22 So that what was promised, being given through faith in Jesus Christ, might be given to those who believe.
11. 3:24 To lead us to Christ that we might be justified by faith.
12. 3:25 Now that faith has come.
13. 3:28 For you are all one in Christ Jesus.

## Galatians 4

1. 4:2,1 The heir (as long as he is a child) (he).
2. 4:5,4 God sent his Son to redeem those under the law.
3. 4:6 Because you are sons.
4. 4:8 Formerly when you did not know God.
5. 4:9 Those weak and miserable principles.
6. 4:14 As if I were an angel of God, as if I were Christ Jesus himself.
7. 4:15 That if you could have done so, you would have torn out your eyes and given them to me.
8. 4:18 Provided the purpose is good, and to be so always and not just when I am with you.
9. 4:22 One by the slave woman and the other by the free woman.
10. 4:24,23 The slave woman and the free woman (the women).
11. 4:25 Because she is in slavery with her children.
12. 4:29 The son born in the ordinary way.
13. 4:30 "Get rid of the slave woman and her son, for the slave woman's son will never share in the inheritance with the free woman's son".
