1. 5:1 A yoke of slavery.
2. 5:5 By faith through the Spirit.
3. 5:6 In Christ Jesus.

## Ephesians 1

4. 1:9-10 To bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ.
5. 1:11 Having been predestined according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity to the purpose of his will.
6. 1:14,13 The promised Holy Spirit.
7. 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation so that you may know him better.
8. 1:18-19 That the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and his incomparably great power for us who believe.
9. 1:20-21 At his right hand in the heavenly realms, far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every title that can be given, not only in the present age but also in the one to come.

## Ephesians 2

1. 2:2,1 When you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air.
2. 2:5 Grace.
3. 2:7 The incomparable riches of his grace expressed in his kindness to us in Christ Jesus.
4. 2:8 By grace, through faith -- and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God.
5. 2:10 Created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
6. 2:12 Separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world.
7. 2:15,16 To create in himself one new man out of the two, thus making peace, and in this one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross.
8. 2:19-20 On the foundation of the apostle and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone.
9. 2:22 To become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.

## Ephesians 3

1. 3:5,4 The mystery of Christ.
2. 3:6 That through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus.
3. 3:7 By the gift of God's grace given me through the working of his power.
4. 3:10 That now through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms.
5. 3:12 Freedom and confidence.
6. 3:15,14 His whole family in heaven and on earth.
7. 3:16-17 So that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith.
8. 3:18,17 How wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ.
9. 3:20,19 God (him).
