Ephesians 6

1. 6:1 For this is right.
2. 6:2 Honor your father and mother.
3. 6:4 In the training and instruction of the Lord.
4. 6:5 With respect and fear, and with sincerity of heart, just as you would obey Christ.
5. 6:7-8 Because you know that the Lord will reward everyone for whatever good he does, whether he is slave or free.
6. 6:10 In the Lord and in his mighty power.
7. 6:11 Put on the full armor of God.
8. 6:12 The rulers, the authorities, the powers of this dark world and the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.
9. 6:14-15 With the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.
10. 6:16 The shield of faith.
11. 6:18 All the saints.
12. 6:20,19 The gospel.

Philippians 1

1. 1:4,5 Because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now.
2. 1:6 He who began a good work in you.
3. 1:7 The gospel.
4. 1:9-11 So that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ.
5. 1:11 The fruit of righteousness.
6. 1:12-13 As a result it has become clear throughout the whole palace guard and to everyone else that I am in chains for Christ.
7. 1:14 Because of my chains.
8. 1:18 That in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is preached.
9. 1:20 That I will in no way be ashamed, but will have sufficient courage so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death.
10. 1:21 Gain.
11. 1:23-24 I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far; but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body.
12. 1:27 In a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ.
13. 1:28,27 That you stand firm in one spirit, contending as one man for the faith of the gospel without being frightened in any way by those who oppose you.
14. 1:29 Not only to believe on him but also to suffer for him.

Philippians 2

1. 2:1-2 Then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose.
2. 2:3 Selfish ambition or vain conceit.
3. 2:5 The same as that of Christ Jesus.
4. 2:7,5 Christ Jesus.
5. 2:10-11 The name of Jesus.
6. 2:12-13 For it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose.
7. 2:14-15 So that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation.
8. 2:15-16 As you hold out the word of life.
9. 2:16 That I did not run or labor for nothing.
10. 2:20-21 For everyone looks out for his own interests, not those of Jesus Christ.
11. 2:22 As a son with his father.
12. 2:25-26 For he longs for all of you and is distressed because you heard he was ill.
13. 2:27 To spare me sorrow upon sorrow.
14. 2:29-30 Because he almost died for the work of Christ, risking his life to make up for the help you could not give me.
