Colossians 2:6 - Philemon 1:25

Colossians 2

1. 2:6-7 Just as you received him as Lord, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.
2. 2:8 That no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the basic principles of this world rather than on Christ.
3. 2:9 All the fullness of the Deity.
4. 2:13-14 Having canceled the written code, with its regulations, that was against us and that stood opposed to us; he took it away, nailing it to the cross.
5. 2:17 The reality.
6. 2:20 The basic principles of this world.
7. 2:22 Because they are based on human commands and teachings.
8. 2:23 With their self-imposed worship, their false humility and their harsh treatment of the body.

Colossians 3

1. 3:2-3 For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.
2. 3:5 Sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry.
3. 3:8 All such things as these: Anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips.
4. 3:9-10 Since you have taken off your old self with its practices and have put on the new self which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.
5. 3:11,10 With the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator (here).
6. 3:12 Compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.
7. 3:15 Since as members of one body you were called to peace.
8. 3:16 As you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.
9. 3:17 Do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
10. 3:21 Or they will become discouraged.
11. 3:23-24 Since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.
12. 3:25 Anyone who does wrong.

Colossians 4

1. 4:1 Because you know that you also have a Master in heaven.
2. 4:2 Being watchful and thankful.
3. 4:5 Every opportunity.
4. 4:6 So that you may know how to answer everyone.
5. 4:8 That you may know about our circumstances and that he may encourage your hearts.
6. 4:11,10 My fellow prisoner Aristarchus, Mark the cousin of Barnabas, and Jesus who is called Justus.
7. 4:12 Mature and fully assured.
8. 4:18 With my own hand.

Philemon 1

1. 1:4-5 Because I hear about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints.
2. 1:6 So that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ.
3. 1:7 Because you have refreshed the hearts of the saints.
4. 1:9 Love.
5. 1:10 Onesimus.
6. 1:11,10 Onesimus.
7. 1:13 So that he could take your place in helping me while I am in chains for the gospel.
8. 1:15-16 That you might have him back for good--no longer as a slave, but better than a slave, as a dear brother.
9. 1:16 Both as a man and as a brother in the Lord.
10. 1:18-19 Charge it to me. I will pay it back.
11. 1:22 Because I hope to be restored to you in answer to your prayers.
12. 1:25 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ.
