1. 1:3 The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead
2. 1:4 An inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading
3. 1:5 The salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time
4. 1:7 The proven character of your faith
5. 1:9 The goal of your faith, the salvation of your souls
6. 1:12 When they foretold the things now announced by those who preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven
