1 Peter 2

1. 2:1 All malice, deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and slander
2. 2:2 That the Lord is good
3. 2:5 To be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ
4. 2:7 The stone the builders rejected
5. 2:9 A chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession
6. 2:11 To abstain from the desires of the flesh, which war against your soul
7. 2:12 With such honor among the Gentiles that, though they slander you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day He visits us
8. 2:13 Every human institution
9. 2:15 That by doing good you should silence the ignorance of foolish men
10. 2:17 Love the brotherhood of believers, fear God, honor the king
11. 2:18 With all respect, not only to those who are good and gentle, but even to those who are unreasonable

4. 3:5 How the holy women of the past adorned themselves
