1 Peter 4

1. 4:3 The same desires as the Gentiles: living in debauchery, lust, drunkenness, orgies, carousing, and detestable idolatry
2. 4:4 It strange of you not to plunge with them into the same flood of reckless indiscretion
3. 4:5 Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead
4. 4:6 Why the gospel was preached even to those who are now dead
5. 4:7 So that you can pray
6. 4:8 Because love covers over a multitude of sins
7. 4:10 As good stewards of the manifold grace of God / to serve one another
8. 4:11 So that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be the glory and the power forever and ever. Amen
9. 4:13 So that you may be overjoyed at the revelation of His glory
10. 4:16 Do not be ashamed, but glorify God that you bear that name
11. 4:19 Those who suffer according to God's will

1 Peter 5

1. 5:1 A fellow elder, a witness of Christ's sufferings, and a partaker of the glory to be revealed
2. 5:5 Your elders

5. 5:8 Like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour

2 Peter 1

1. 1:2 Through the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord
2. 1:4 So that through them you may become partakers of the divine nature
3. 1:5 Every effort to add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge
4. 1:8 They will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ
5. 1:10 You will never stumble, and you will receive a lavish reception into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ
6. 1:12 You know them and are established in the truth you now have
7. 1:13 Right to refresh your memory as long as I live in the tent of my body
8. 1:16 Cleverly devised fables
9. 1:18 When we were with Him on the holy mountain
10. 1:20 That no prophecy of Scripture comes from one's own interpretation
11. 1:21 The Holy Spirit

2 Peter 2

1. 2:3 The longstanding verdict against them
2. 2:5 When He brought the flood on its ungodly people
3. 2:9 Then the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from trials and to hold the unrighteous for punishment on the day of judgment
4. 2:12 Like irrational animals, creatures of instinct, born to be captured and destroyed
5. 2:15 The wages of wickedness
6. 2:17 Springs without water and mists driven by a storm
7. 2:19 For a man is a slave to whatever has mastered him
8. 2:20 Their final condition is worse than it was at first
9. 2:22 "A dog returns to its vomit," and, "A sow that is washed goes back to her wallowing in the mud."

2 Peter 3

1. 3:1 What was foretold by the holy prophets and commanded by our Lord and Savior through your apostles
2. 3:5 The fact that long ago by God's word the heavens existed and the earth was formed out of water and by water
3. 3:7 Kept for the day of judgment and destruction of ungodly men
4. 3:8 This: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day
5. 3:11 You ought to conduct yourselves in holiness and godliness as you anticipate and hasten the coming of the day of God
6. 3:13 A new heaven and a new earth, where righteousness dwells
7. 3:14 Every effort to be found at peace with Him, without spot or blemish
8. 3:17 So that you will not be carried away by the error of the lawless and fall from your secure standing
