1 Peter 3

1. 3:15 Everyone who asks you the reason for the hope that you have
2. 3:16 Your good behavior in Christ
3. 3:17 If it is God's will, to suffer for doing good than for doing evil
4. 3:19 Long ago when God waited patiently in the days of Noah, while the ark was being built
5. 3:21 The baptism that now saves you also--not the removal of dirt from the body, but the pledge of a clear conscience toward God
6. 3:22 Angels, authorities, and powers

1 Peter 4

1. 4:3 The same desires as the Gentiles: living in debauchery, lust, drunkenness, orgies, carousing, and detestable idolatry
2. 4:4 It strange of you not to plunge with them into the same flood of reckless indiscretion
3. 4:5 Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead
4. 4:6 Why the gospel was preached even to those who are now dead
5. 4:7 So that you can pray
6. 4:8 Because love covers over a multitude of sins
7. 4:10 As good stewards of the manifold grace of God / to serve one another
8. 4:11 So that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be the glory and the power forever and ever. Amen
