Matthew 5

1. 5:34-36 Either by heaven, for it is God's throne; or by the earth, for it is his footstool; or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the Great King.
2. 5:35 Jerusalem.
3. 5:44-45 That you may be sons of your Father in heaven.
4. 5:48 As your heavenly Father is perfect.

Matthew 6

1. 6:1 If you do, you will have no reward from your Father in heaven.
2. 6:2 To be honored by men.
3. 6:3-4 So that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.
4. 6:6 Go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father who is unseen.
5. 6:10 As it is in heaven.
6. 6:15 Your Father will not forgive your sins.
7. 6:17-18 So that it will not be obvious to men that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen.
8. 6:18 Not to men, but only to your Father, who is unseen.
9. 6:19 Treasures on earth.
10. 6:21 Where your treasure is.
11. 6:24 Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other.
12. 6:33,32 Seek first your heavenly Father's (his) kingdom and his righteousness.
13. 6:34 For tomorrow will worry about itself.

Matthew 7

1. 7:2 In the same way you judge others.
2. 7:5 When you first take the plank out of your own eye.
3. 7:11 How much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!.
4. 7:12 For this sums up the Law and the Prophets.
5. 7:13 For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it.
6. 7:21 Not everyone who says to me, "Lord, Lord", but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.
7. 7:24 Everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice.
8. 7:28-29 Because he taught as one who had authority, and not as their teachers of the law.
