Matthew 12

1. 12:38-39 Who - some of the Pharisees and teachers of the law; Reply - "A wicked and adulterous generation asks for a miraculous sign! But none will be given it except the sign of the prophet Jonah".
2. 12:41 They repented at the preaching of Jonah, and now one greater than Jonah is here.
3. 12:42 The Queen of the South.
4. 12:43 When it comes out of a man.
5. 12:44,43 Who: An evil spirit; When: When it comes out of a man and goes through arid places, seeking rest and does not find it; Result: When it arrives, it finds the house unoccupied, swept clean and put in order.
6. 12:45,43-44 An evil spirit returning to the house it left.
7. 12:50 Whoever does the will of my Father in heaven.

Matthew 14

1. 14:3-4 Because of Herodias, his brother Philip's wife, for John had been saying to him: "It is not lawful for you to have her".
2. 14:5 The people.
3. 14:13,12,10 When he heard what had happened (John the Baptist beheaded).
4. 14:15-16,14 Who: The disciples; To: Jesus; Reply: "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat".
5. 14:18,15-17 Who: Jesus; To: the disciples; About: The five loaves of bread and the two fish they had.
6. 14:20 Twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over.
7. 14:21 About five thousand men, besides women and children.
8. 14:23 To pray.
9. 14:25 During the fourth watch of the night.
10. 14:30-31,29 Who - Peter; Why - when he saw the wind, he was afraid, and he was beginning to sink; Response - immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him, and said, "You of little faith, why did you doubt?".
11. 14:35,34 The men of Gennesaret (that place).
12. 14:36,35 To let the sick just touch the edge of his cloak.

Matthew 15

1. 15:3 The command of God.
2. 15:4 "Honor your father and mother," and "Anyone who curses his father or mother must be put to death".
3. 15:6,5 You say that if a man says to his father or mother, "Whatever help you might otherwise have received from me is a gift devoted to God", he is not to 'honor is father' with it.
4. 15:7-9 When he prophesied about you: "These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. They worship me in vain; their teachings are but rules taught by men".
5. 15:9,8 This people's (their) teachings.
6. 15:11 What comes out of a man's mouth.
7. 15:18 The things that come out of the mouth come from the heart and these make a man 'unclean'.
8. 15:19 Evil thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander.
9. 15:22-23,21 Who: A Canaanite woman from the vicinity of Tyre and Sidon; To: Jesus; Response: Jesus did not answer a word.
10. 15:27 The crumbs that fall from their masters' table.
11. 15:27,22-23,26 Who: The Canaanite woman whose daughter was suffering from demon-possession; To: Jesus; In reply to: "I was only sent to the lost sheep of Israel".
12. 15:28,22 Who: Jesus; To: The Canaanite woman whose daughter was suffering from demon-possession; Result: Her daughter was healed from that very hour.
13. 15:31 When they saw the mute speaking, the crippled made well, the lame walking, and the blind seeing.
14. 15:37 The disciples.

Matthew 16

1. 16:4 None except the sign of Jonah.
2. 16:12 That he was not telling them to guard against the yeast used in bread, but against the teaching of the Pharisees and Sadducees.
3. 16:13-14 Who - Jesus; To - his disciples; Reply - "Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets".
4. 16:16-17 Who - Simon Peter; To - Jesus; Reply - "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by man, but by my Father in heaven".
5. 16:17 This was not revealed to you by man, but by my Father in heaven.
6. 16:18 The gates of Hades.
7. 16:19 The keys of the kingdom of heaven.
8. 16:21 That he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things at the hands of the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and on the third day be raised to life.
9. 16:22-23 Who - Peter; To - Jesus; Reply - "Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; you do not have in mind the things of God, but the things of men".
10. 16:24-25 For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will find it.
11. 16:27 When he comes in his Father's glory with his angels.
12. 16:28 Some who are standing here will not taste death before they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom.
