Matthew 27

- 1. 27:32 A man from Cyrene, named Simon.
- 2. 27:35 By casting lots.
- 3. 27:37 The written charge against him: THIS IS JESUS, THE KING OF THE JEWS.
- 4. 27:40,39,34 Who those who passed by; To Jesus; How hurled insults at him, shaking their heads.
- 5. 27:42,41,34 Who: The chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders; About: Jesus; How: They mocked him.
- 6. 27:45 From the sixth hour until the ninth hour.
- 7. 27:46 Who Jesus; When about the ninth hour; How cried out in a loud voice.
- 8. 27:51,50 At the moment Jesus gave up his spirit (that moment).
- 9. 27:52 The tombs.
- 10. 27:53,52 Many holy people who had died and whose bodies were raised to life.
- 11. 27:54 Who: The centurion and those with him who were guarding Jesus; When: When they saw the earthquake and all that had happened; How: They were terrified and exclaimed.
- 12. 27:57 A rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph.

Matthew 28

- 1. 28:1 After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week.
- 2. 28:2 For an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it.
- 3. 28:4 So afraid that they shook and became like dead men.
- 4. 28:5,1 Who the angel; To Mary Magdalene and the other Mary (the women).
- 5. 28:7 "He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him".
- 6. 28:8,1 Mary Magdalene and the other Mary (the women).

- 10. 28:18 All authority in heaven and on earth.
- 11. 28:19-20 Baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.
- 12. 28:20 Always, to the very end of the age.
