Matthew 6

1. 6:1 If you do, you will have no reward from your Father in heaven.
2. 6:2 To be honored by men.
3. 6:3-4 So that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.
4. 6:5 The hypocrites who love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen by men.
5. 6:6 Go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father who is unseen.
6. 6:8 Your Father.
7. 6:10 As it is in heaven.
8. 6:12 As we also have forgiven our debtors.
9. 6:15 Your Father will not forgive your sins.
10. 6:17-18 So that it will not be obvious to men that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen.
11. 6:19 Treasures on earth.
12. 6:21 Where your treasure is.
13. 6:23 How great is that darkness!.
14. 6:24 Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other.
15. 6:25 "Do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more important than food, and the body more important than clothes?".
16. 6:28 How the lilies of the field grow.
17. 6:30 Will he not much more clothe you?.
18. 6:33,32 Seek first your heavenly Father's (his) kingdom and his righteousness.

Matthew 7

1. 7:2 In the same way you judge others.
2. 7:5 When you first take the plank out of your own eye.
3. 7:6 If you do, they may trample them under their feet, and then turn and tear you to pieces.
4. 7:11 Those who ask him.
5. 7:11 How much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!.
6. 7:12 For this sums up the Law and the Prophets.
7. 7:13 For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it.
8. 7:15 In sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves.
9. 7:21 Not everyone who says to me, "Lord, Lord", but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.
10. 7:24 Everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice.
11. 7:27 (When) the rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against it.
12. 7:28-29 Because he taught as one who had authority, and not as their teachers of the law.

Matthew 8

1. 8:3,2 Who: Jesus; To: The man with leprosy; Result: Immediately he was cured of his leprosy.
2. 8:4,2 Who: Jesus; To: The man whom he had cured of his leprosy.
3. 8:6,5,7 Who - a centurion; To - Jesus; Reply - "I will go and heal him".
4. 8:8-9 For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, "Go", and he goes; and that one, "Come", and he comes. I say to my servant, "Do this", and he does it.
5. 8:10,8 Who: Jesus; To: Those following him; About: The centurion.
6. 8:11 Many from the east and the west.
7. 8:14 Peter's mother-in-law.
8. 8:17,16 When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick.
9. 8:19-20 Who: A teacher of the law; To: Jesus; Reply: "Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head".
10. 8:22,21 Who: Jesus; To: another disciple; In reply to: "Lord, first let me go and bury my Father".
11. 8:24 Without warning, so that the waves swept over the boat.
12. 8:25 Who: The disciples; To: Jesus; How: They woke him.
13. 8:27 Who: The disciples (the men); About: Jesus; In response to: Jesus rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm.
14. 8:29,28 Who: Two demon-possessed men coming from the tombs; How: They shouted.
15. 8:32,31 The whole herd (of pigs).
