4. 11:8 God gave them a spirit of stupor, eyes that would not see and ears that would not hear, down to this very day.
5. 11:24 How much more will these, the natural branches, be grafted back into their own olive tree
6. 11:25 This: a partial hardening has come upon Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in
