Philippians 3

1. 3:1 To write the same things to you again
2. 3:2 Those dogs, those workers of evil, those mutilators of the flesh!
3. 3:4 I have more
4. 3:7 Whatever was gain to me
5. 3:8 The surpassing excellence of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord
6. 3:9 My own righteousness from the law
7. 3:10 To know Christ and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, and so, somehow, to attain to the resurrection from the dead
8. 3:12 That for which Christ Jesus took hold of me
9. 3:13 Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize of God's heavenly calling in Christ Jesus
10. 3:15 God will reveal this to you as well
11. 3:17 Those who walk according to the pattern we set for you
12. 3:18 Many live as enemies of the cross of Christ
13. 3:20 A Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ

Philippians 4

1. 4:1 You (My brothers, whom I love and long for, my joy and crown) / My beloved
2. 4:3 To help these women who have labored with me for the gospel, along with Clement and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the Book of Life
3. 4:5 The Lord is near
4. 4:7 The peace of God, which surpasses all understanding
5. 4:8 These things (Whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable--if anything is excellent or praiseworthy)
6. 4:10 At last you have revived your concern for me
7. 4:11 For I have learned to be content regardless of my circumstances
8. 4:12 How to live humbly, and I know how to abound
9. 4:15 In the early days of the gospel, when I left Macedonia, no church but you partnered with me in the matter of giving and receiving
10. 4:18 Now that I have received your gifts from Epaphroditus
11. 4:19 According to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus
12. 4:22 All the saints, especially those from the household of Caesar

Colossians 1

1. 1:3 Because we have heard about your faith in Christ Jesus and your love for all the saints
2. 1:6 Just as it has been doing among you since the day you heard it and truly understood the grace of God
3. 1:7 Epaphras, our beloved fellow servant, who is a faithful minister of Christ on our behalf
4. 1:9 Praying for you and asking God to fill you with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding
5. 1:12 The inheritance of the saints in the light
6. 1:13 His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins
7. 1:16 All things, things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities
8. 1:18 The head of the body, the church; the beginning and firstborn from among the dead
9. 1:20 By making peace through the blood of His cross
10. 1:22 By Christ's physical body through death
11. 1:23 Every creature under heaven
12. 1:24 What is lacking in regard to Christ's afflictions for the sake of His body, which is the church
13. 1:25 The commission God gave me to fully proclaim to you the word of God
14. 1:27 Christ in you, the hope of glory
15. 1:28 So that we may present everyone perfect in Christ
16. 1:29 With all His energy working powerfully within me

Colossians 2

1. 2:1 How much I am struggling for you and for those at Laodicea, and for all who have not met me face to face
2. 2:2 So that they may know the mystery of God, namely Christ
3. 2:3 All the treasures of wisdom and knowledge
4. 2:5 Absent from you in body, present with you in spirit
