Ephesians 6:1 - Ephesians 6:24, Philippians 1:1 - Philippians 2:30

Ephesians 6

1. 6:1 For this is right
2. 6:2 That it may go well with you and that you may have a long life on the earth
3. 6:4 The discipline and instruction of the Lord
4. 6:5 With respect and fear and sincerity of heart, just as you would obey Christ
5. 6:6 As servants of Christ, doing the will of God from your heart
6. 6:7 With good will, as to the Lord and not to men
7. 6:8 That the Lord will reward each one for whatever good he does, whether he is slave or free
8. 6:9 Because you know that He who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and there is no favoritism with Him
9. 6:11 So that you can make your stand against the devil's schemes
10. 6:12 The rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this world's darkness, and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms
11. 6:13 So that when the day of evil comes, you will be able to stand your ground, and having done everything, to stand
12. 6:14 With the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness arrayed, and with your feet fitted with the readiness of the gospel of peace
13. 6:16 The shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one
14. 6:17 The helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God
15. 6:19 That whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will boldly make known the mystery of the gospel
16. 6:22 For this very purpose, that you may know about us, and that he may encourage your hearts

Philippians 1

1. 1:1 Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
2. 1:4 Because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now
3. 1:6 He who began a good work in you
4. 1:7 My chains and in my defense and confirmation of the gospel
5. 1:8 My witness how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus
6. 1:9 So that you may be able to test and prove what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ
7. 1:12 That my circumstances have actually served to advance the gospel
8. 1:16 That I am appointed for the defense of the gospel
9. 1:18 Just this: that in every way, whether by false motives or true, Christ is preached
10. 1:19 That through your prayers and the provision of the Spirit of Jesus Christ, my distress will turn out for my deliverance
11. 1:20 So that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death
12. 1:23 I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better indeed
13. 1:25 That I will remain and will continue with all of you for your progress and joy in the faith
14. 1:27 Contending side by side for the faith of the gospel, without being frightened in any way by those who oppose you
15. 1:29 Not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for Him
16. 1:30 The same struggle you saw I had, and now hear that I still have

Philippians 2

1. 2:2 By being like-minded, having the same love, being united in spirit and purpose
2. 2:3 More important than yourselves
3. 2:10 At the name of Jesus / In heaven and on earth and under the earth
4. 2:12 To work out your salvation with fear and trembling
5. 2:13 To will and to act on behalf of His good purpose
6. 2:14 So that you may be blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and perverse generation, in which you shine as lights in the world
7. 2:17 I am glad and rejoice with all of you
8. 2:19 That I also may be cheered when I learn how you are doing
9. 2:22 Timothy's proven worth, that as a child with his father he has served with me to advance the gospel
10. 2:23 To send him as soon as I see what happens with me
11. 2:25 To send back to you Epaphroditus, my brother, fellow worker, and fellow soldier, who is also your messenger and minister to my needs
12. 2:28 So that when you see him again you may rejoice, and I may be less anxious
13. 2:29 Because he nearly died for the work of Christ, risking his life to make up for your deficit of service to me
