Ephesians 6

1. 6:11 So that you can make your stand against the devil's schemes
2. 6:12 The rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this world's darkness, and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms
3. 6:13 So that when the day of evil comes, you will be able to stand your ground, and having done everything, to stand
4. 6:14 With the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness arrayed, and with your feet fitted with the readiness of the gospel of peace
5. 6:16 The shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one
6. 6:17 The word of God
7. 6:19 That whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will boldly make known the mystery of the gospel
