- 1. 2:6 Just as you have received Christ Jesus as Lord / Rooted and built up in Him, established in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness
- 2. 2:8 No one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deception
- 3. 2:12 Your faith in the power of God, who raised Him from the dead
- 4. 2:13 Your trespasses and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature
- 5. 2:13 When you were dead in your trespasses and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature
- 6. 2:16 What you eat or drink, or with regard to a feast, a New Moon, or a Sabbath
- 7. 2:18 With speculation about what he has seen
- 8. 2:19 The head, from whom the whole body, supported and knit together by its joints and ligaments, grows as God causes it to grow
- 9. 2:20 Why, as though you still belonged to the world, do you submit to its regulations: "Do not handle, do not taste, do not touch!"?
