## Galatians 1

1. 1:2 God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
2. 1:6 The One who called you by the grace of Christ
3. 1:9 If anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to the one you received, let him be under a curse!
4. 1:11 That the gospel I preached was not devised by man
5. 1:13 How severely I persecuted the church of God and tried to destroy it
6. 1:15 God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me His grace
7. 1:16 When God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me by His grace, was pleased to reveal His Son in me so that I might preach Him among the Gentiles
8. 1:20 That what I am writing to you is no lie
9. 1:21 To the regions of Syria and Cilicia
10. 1:23 "The man who formerly persecuted us is now preaching the faith he once tried to destroy."

## Galatians 2

1. 2:2 For fear that I was running or had already run in vain
2. 2:2 The gospel that I preach among the Gentiles
3. 2:4 Because some false brothers had come in under false pretenses to spy on our freedom in Christ Jesus, in order to enslave us
4. 2:5 A moment
5. 2:7 That I had been entrusted to preach the gospel to the uncircumcised, just as Peter had been to the circumcised
6. 2:8 The One who was at work in Peter's apostleship to the circumcised
7. 2:9 So that we should go to the Gentiles, and they to the circumcised
8. 2:12 Before certain men came from James
9. 2:15 That a man is not justified by works of the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ
10. 2:16 That we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified
11. 2:20 Faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me
12. 2:21 For if righteousness comes through the law, Christ died for nothing

## Galatians 3

1. 3:2 Just one thing: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law, or by hearing with faith?
2. 3:7 That those who have faith are sons of Abraham
3. 3:10 "Cursed is everyone who does not continue to do everything written in the Book of the Law."
4. 3:11 That no one is justified before God by the law
5. 3:13 "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."
6. 3:14 So that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit
7. 3:17 The covenant previously established by God
8. 3:19 It was added because of transgressions, until the arrival of the seed to whom the promise referred
9. 3:21 Then righteousness would certainly have come from the law
10. 3:22 So that by faith in Jesus Christ the promise might be given to those who believe
11. 3:24 That we might be justified by faith
12. 3:27 All of you who were baptized into Christ
13. 3:28 All one in Christ Jesus

## Galatians 4

1. 4:1 That as long as the heir is a child, he is no different from a slave, although he is the owner of everything
2. 4:4 To redeem those under the law, that we might receive our adoption as sons
3. 4:8 Those who by nature are not gods
4. 4:13 That it was because of an illness that I first preached the gospel to you
5. 4:15 You would have torn out your eyes and given them to me
6. 4:22 That Abraham had two sons, one by the slave woman and the other by the free woman
7. 4:24 For the women represent two covenants
8. 4:25 Because she is in slavery with her children
9. 4:27 "Rejoice, O barren woman, who bears no children; break forth and cry aloud, you who have never travailed; because more are the children of the desolate woman than of her who has a husband."
10. 4:30 "Expel the slave woman and her son, for the slave woman's son will never share in the inheritance with the free woman's son."
