

1 Corinthians 8

1. Knowledge puffs up, but what builds up?  
8:1 Love
2. Who does not yet know as he ought to know?  
8:2 The one who thinks he knows something
3. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 8 verse 4, We know what?  
8:4 That an idol is nothing at all in the world, and that there is no God but one
4. We exist through whom?  
8:6 One Lord, Jesus Christ
5. Be careful, however, that what?  
8:9 Your freedom does not become a stumbling block to the weak
6. What if someone with a weak conscience sees you who are well informed eating in an idol's temple?  
8:10 Will he not be encouraged to eat food sacrificed to idols?
7. Who is destroyed by your knowledge?  
8:11 This weak brother, for whom Christ died
8. What if what I eat causes my brother to stumble?  
8:13 I will never eat meat again, so that I will not cause him to stumble

1 Corinthians 9

1. For you are the seal of what?  
9:2 My apostleship in the Lord
2. Who take along a believing wife?  
9:5 The other apostles and the Lord's brothers and Cephas
3. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 9, What is written in the Law of Moses?  
9:9 "Do not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain."
4. What if we have sown spiritual seed among you?  
9:11 Is it too much for us to reap a material harvest from you?
5. What has the Lord prescribed?  
9:14 That those who preach the gospel should receive their living from the gospel
6. And I am not writing this to suggest what?  
9:15 That something be done for me
7. Yet when I preach the gospel, I have no reason to boast, why?  
9:16 Because I am obligated to preach
8. What then is my reward?  
9:18 That in preaching the gospel I may offer it free of charge, and so not use up my rights in preaching it
9. I make myself a slave to everyone, why?  
9:19 To win as many as possible
10. Why have I become all things to all people?  
9:22 So that by all possible means I might save some
11. Run how?  
9:24 In such a way as to take the prize
12. How do I not fight?  
9:26 Like I am beating the air
13. I discipline my body and make it my slave, why?  
9:27 So that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified

1 Corinthians 10

1. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 10 verse 1, What do I not want?  
10:1 You to be unaware, brothers, that our forefathers were all under the cloud, and that they all passed through the sea
2. They all ate the same spiritual food and drank what?  
10:3 The same spiritual drink
3. These things took place as examples why?  
10:6 To keep us from craving evil things as they did
4. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 10 verse 7, What is written?  
10:7 "The people sat down to eat and drink and got up to indulge in revelry."
5. And in one day how many of them died?  
10:8 Twenty-three thousand
6. Do not complain, as some of them did, and were killed by whom?  
10:10 The destroying angel
7. Who should be careful not to fall?  
10:12 The one who thinks he is standing firm

8. When will He also provide an escape?  
10:13 When you are tempted
9. What is a participation in the blood of Christ?  
10:16 The cup of blessing that we bless
10. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 10 verse 17, Why are we who are many one body?  
10:17 Because there is one loaf / For we all partake of the one loaf
11. Am I suggesting, then, that food sacrificed to an idol is anything, or that an idol is anything?  
10:19 No, but the sacrifices of pagans are offered to demons, not to God
12. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 10 verse 23, Not everything is what?  
10:23 Beneficial, edifying
13. What should no one seek?  
10:24 His own good
14. Eat anything sold in the meat market without raising questions of conscience, why?  
10:25 For, "The earth is the Lord's, and the fullness thereof."
15. What if an unbeliever invites you to a meal and you want to go?  
10:27 Eat anything set before you without raising questions of conscience
16. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 10 verse 29, I mean what?  
10:29 The other one's conscience, not your own
17. Do not become a stumbling block, whether to whom?  
10:32 Jews or Greeks or the church of God
18. What am I seeking?  
10:33 The good of many, that they may be saved

#### 1 Corinthians 11

1. Now I commend you for what?  
11:2 Remembering me in everything and for maintaining the traditions, just as I passed them on to you
2. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 11 verse 3, I want what?  
11:3 You to understand that the head of every man is Christ, and the head of the woman is man, and the head of Christ is God
3. Who dishonors his head?  
11:4 Every man who prays or prophesies with his head covered
4. For this reason a woman ought to have a sign of authority on her head, why?  
11:10 Because of the angels
5. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 11 verse 13, Judge for yourselves what?  
11:13 Is it proper for a woman to pray to God with her head uncovered?
6. What if anyone is inclined to dispute this?  
11:16 We have no other practice, nor do the churches of God
