1. 8:1 Love
2. 8:2 The one who thinks he knows something
3. 8:4 That an idol is nothing at all in the world, and that there is no God but one
4. 8:6 One Lord, Jesus Christ
5. 8:9 Your freedom does not become a stumbling block to the weak
6. 8:10 Will he not be encouraged to eat food sacrificed to idols?
7. 8:11 This weak brother, for whom Christ died
8. 8:13 I will never eat meat again, so that I will not cause him to stumble

## 1 Corinthians 9

1. 9:2 My apostleship in the Lord
2. 9:5 The other apostles and the Lord's brothers and Cephas
3. 9:9 "Do not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain."
4. 9:11 Is it too much for us to reap a material harvest from you?
5. 9:14 That those who preach the gospel should receive their living from the gospel
6. 9:15 That something be done for me
7. 9:16 Because I am obligated to preach
8. 9:18 That in preaching the gospel I may offer it free of charge, and so not use up my rights in preaching it

3. 10:6 To keep us from craving evil things as they did
4. 10:7 "The people sat down to eat and drink and got up to indulge in revelry."
5. 10:8 Twenty-three thousand
6. 10:10 The destroying angel
7. 10:12 The one who thinks he is standing firm
8. 10:13 When you are tempted
9. 10:16 The cup of blessing that we bless
10. 10:17 Because there is one loaf / For we all partake of the one loaf
11. 10:19 No, but the sacrifices of pagans are offered to demons, not to God
12. 10:23 Beneficial, edifying
13. 10:24 His own good
14. 10:25 For, "The earth is the Lord's, and the fullness thereof."
15. 10:27 Eat anything set before you without raising questions of conscience

## 1 Corinthians 11

1. 11:2 Remembering me in everything and for maintaining the traditions, just as I passed them on to you
2. 11:3 You to understand that the head of every man is Christ, and the head of the woman is man, and the head of Christ is God
3. 11:4 Every man who prays or prophesies with his head covered
4. 11:10 Because of the angels
5. 11:13 Is it proper for a woman to pray to God with her head uncovered?
6. 11:16 We have no other practice, nor do the churches of God
