14. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 10 verse 17, Why are we who are many one body?
10:17 Because there is one loaf / For we all partake of the one loaf
15. Am I suggesting, then, that food sacrificed to an idol is anything, or that an idol is anything?
10:19 No, but the sacrifices of pagans are offered to demons, not to God
16. You cannot partake in the table of the Lord and the table of what too?
10:21 Demons
17. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 10 verse 23, Not everything is what?
10:23 Beneficial, edifying
18. What should no one seek?
10:24 His own good
19. Eat anything sold in the meat market without raising questions of conscience, why?
10:25 For, "The earth is the Lord's, and the fullness thereof."
