1. Earnestly pursue love and eagerly desire what?
14:1 Spiritual gifts, especially the gift of prophecy
2. But he who prophesies speaks to men for what?
14:3 Their edification, encouragement, and comfort
3. Why would I rather have you prophesy?
14:5 He who prophesies is greater than one who speaks in tongues, unless he interprets, so that the church may be edified
4. What then shall I do?
14:15 I will pray with my spirit, but I will also pray with my mind / I will sing with my spirit, but I will also sing with my mind
5. But in the church, I would rather speak what?
14:19 Five coherent words to instruct others
6. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 14 verse 20, Be what?
14:20 Infants in regard to evil, mature in your thinking
7. How will I speak to this people?
14:21 By strange tongues and foreign lips
8. What if an unbeliever or uninstructed person comes in while everyone is prophesying?
14:24 He will be convicted and called to account by all, and the secrets of his heart will be made known
9. What then shall we say, brothers?
14:26 When you come together, everyone has a psalm or a teaching, a revelation, a tongue, or an interpretation
10. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 14, What if there is no interpreter?
14:28 He should remain silent in the church and speak only to himself and God
11. Why are the spirits of prophets subject to prophets?
14:32 For God is not a God of disorder, but of peace
12. What if anyone considers himself a prophet or spiritual person?
14:37 Let him acknowledge that what I am writing you is the Lord's command
13. Be eager to prophesy, and do not forbid what?
14:39 Speaking in tongues

1 Corinthians 15

1. Now, brothers, I want to remind you of what?
15:1 The gospel I preached to you, which you received, and in which you stand firm
2. By this gospel you are saved, if what?
15:2 You hold firmly to the word I preached to you
3. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 15, I passed what on to you as of first importance?
15:3 What I received: That Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures
4. He was raised on the third day according to what?
15:4 To the Scriptures
5. After that, He appeared to whom?
15:6 More than five hundred brothers, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep
6. And last of all He appeared to me also, how?
15:8 As to one of untimely birth
7. Why am I the least of the apostles and am unworthy to be called an apostle?
15:9 Because I persecuted the church of God
8. What if it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead?
15:12 How can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?
9. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 15 verse 14, What if Christ has not been raised?
15:14 Our preaching is worthless, and so is your faith
10. In that case, we are also exposed as false witnesses about God why?
15:15 For we have testified about God that He raised Christ from the dead, but He did not raise Him if in fact the dead are not raised
11. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 15 verse 16, What if the dead are not raised?
15:16 Then not even Christ has been raised
12. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 15 verse 17, What if Christ has not been raised?
15:17 Your faith is futile; you are still in your sins
13. What if our hope in Christ is for this life alone?
15:19 We are to be pitied more than all men

14. Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of whom?
15:20 Those who have fallen asleep
15. What comes also through a man?
15:21 The resurrection of the dead
16. He hands over the kingdom to God the Father after He has destroyed what?
15:24 All dominion, authority, and power
17. What is death?
15:26 The last enemy to be destroyed
18. Now when it says that everything has been put under Him, this clearly does not include whom?
15:27 The One who put everything under Him
19. Why will the Son Himself be made subject to Him who put all things under Him?
15:28 So that God may be all in all
20. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 15 verse 29, What if the dead are not raised at all?
15:29 Why are people baptized for them?
21. I face death every day, brothers, as surely as what?
15:31 I boast about you in Christ Jesus our Lord
22. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 15 verse 32, What if the dead are not raised?
15:32 "Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die."
23. Bad company corrupts what?
15:33 Good character
24. But someone will ask, what?
15:35 How are the dead raised? / With what kind of body will they come?
25. How is not all flesh the same?
15:39 Men have one kind of flesh, animals have another, birds another, and fish another
26. How will it be with the resurrection of the dead?
15:42 What is sown is perishable; it is raised imperishable
27. What if there is a natural body?
15:44 There is also a spiritual body
28. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 15 verse 45, What is written?
15:45 "The first man Adam became a living being;" the last Adam a life-giving spirit
29. Now I declare to you, brothers, what?
15:50 That flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable
30. I tell you what mystery?
15:51 We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed
31. What will come to pass when the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable and the mortal with immortality?
15:54 The saying that is written: "Death has been swallowed up in victory."
32. Always excel in the work of the Lord, why?
15:58 Because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain
