## 1 Corinthians 14

1. 14:1 Spiritual gifts, especially the gift of prophecy
2. 14:3 Their edification, encouragement, and comfort
3. 14:5 He who prophesies is greater than one who speaks in tongues, unless he interprets, so that the church may be edified
4. 14:15 I will pray with my spirit, but I will also pray with my mind / I will sing with my spirit, but I will also sing with my mind
5. 14:19 Five coherent words to instruct others
6. 14:20 Infants in regard to evil, mature in your thinking
7. 14:21 By strange tongues and foreign lips
8. 14:24 He will be convicted and called to account by all, and the secrets of his heart will be made known
9. 14:26 When you come together, everyone has a psalm or a teaching, a revelation, a tongue, or an interpretation
10. 14:28 He should remain silent in the church and speak only to himself and God
11. 14:32 For God is not a God of disorder, but of peace

## 1 Corinthians 15

1. 15:1 The gospel I preached to you, which you received, and in which you stand firm
2. 15:2 You hold firmly to the word I preached to you
3. 15:3 What I received: That Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures
4. 15:4 To the Scriptures
5. 15:6 More than five hundred brothers, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep
6. 15:8 As to one of untimely birth
7. 15:9 Because I persecuted the church of God
8. 15:12 How can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?
9. 15:14 Our preaching is worthless, and so is your faith
10. 15:15 For we have testified about God that He raised Christ from the dead, but He did not raise Him if in fact the dead are not raised
11. 15:16 Then not even Christ has been raised
12. 15:17 Your faith is futile; you are still in your sins
13. 15:19 We are to be pitied more than all men
14. 15:20 Those who have fallen asleep
15. 15:21 The resurrection of the dead
16. 15:24 All dominion, authority, and power
17. 15:26 The last enemy to be destroyed
18. 15:27 The One who put everything under Him
19. 15:28 So that God may be all in all
20. 15:29 Why are people baptized for them?
