

## 1 Corinthians 11

1. In the following instructions I have no praise to offer, why?  
11:17 Because your gatherings do more harm than good
2. First of all, I hear what?  
11:18 That when you come together as a church, there are divisions among you
3. Why must there be differences among you?  
11:19 To show which of you are approved
4. Why is it not the Lord's Supper you eat?  
11:20 For as you eat, each of you goes ahead without sharing his meal
5. For I received from the Lord what?  
11:23 What I also passed on to you
6. And when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, what?  
11:24 "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me."
7. After supper He took the cup, saying, what?  
11:25 "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."
8. As often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim what?  
11:26 The Lord's death until He comes
9. Who will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord?  
11:27 Whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner
10. Why must each one examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup?  
11:28 For anyone who eats and drinks without recognizing the body eats and drinks judgment on himself
11. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 11 verse 30, Who have fallen asleep?  
11:30 A number of you
12. When are we being disciplined so that we will not be condemned with the world?  
11:32 When we are judged by the Lord
13. Wait for one another when?  
11:33 When you come together to eat
14. What if anyone is hungry?  
11:34 He should eat at home, so that when you come together it will not result in judgment

## 1 Corinthians 12

1. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 12 verse 1, What do I not want?  
12:1 You to be uninformed about spiritual gifts
2. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 12 verse 2, You know what?  
12:2 That when you were pagans, you were influenced and led astray to mute idols
3. Therefore I inform you what?  
12:3 That no one who is speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus be cursed," and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit
4. Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given why?  
12:7 For the common good
5. All these are the work of whom?  
12:11 One and the same Spirit, who apportions them to each one as He determines
6. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 12, Who were all baptized into one body?  
12:13 We all, whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free
7. What if the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body"?  
12:15 That would not make it any less a part of the body
8. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 12 verse 16, What would not make it any less a part of the body?  
12:16 That (And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body")
9. What if the whole body were an ear?  
12:17 Where would the sense of smell be?
10. What if they were all one part?  
12:19 Where would the body be?
11. The eye cannot say to the hand, what?  
12:21 "I do not need you."
12. What are indispensable?  
12:22 The parts of the body that seem to be weaker
13. And the parts we consider less honorable, we treat how?  
12:23 With greater honor

14. Why has God composed the body and has given greater honor to the parts that lacked it?  
12:24 So that there should be no division in the body, but that its members should have mutual concern for one another
15. What if one part is honored?  
12:26 Every part rejoices with it
16. You are the body of Christ, and each of you is what?  
12:27 A member of it
17. And in the church God has appointed whom?  
12:28 First of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then workers of miracles, and those with gifts of healing, helping, administration, and various tongues
18. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 12 verse 31, Eagerly desire what?  
12:31 The greater gifts

#### 1 Corinthians 13

1. What if I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love?  
13:1 I am only a ringing gong or a clanging cymbal
2. What if I have absolute faith so as to move mountains, but have not love?  
13:2 I am nothing
3. What if I give all I possess to the poor and exult in the surrender of my body, but have not love?  
13:3 I gain nothing
4. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 13 verse 4, What is love?  
13:4 Patient, kind
5. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 13 verse 5, It is not what?  
13:5 Rude, self-seeking, easily angered
6. What rejoices in the truth?  
13:6 Love
7. What will be restrained?  
13:8 They (Tongues)
8. What never fails?  
13:8 Love
9. For we know how?  
13:9 In part
10. The partial passes away when?  
13:10 When the perfect comes
11. When I became a man, I set aside what?  
13:11 Childish ways
12. Now I know in part; then I shall know how?  
13:12 Fully, even as I am fully known
13. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 13 verse 13, What is love?  
13:13 The greatest of these (Faith, hope, and love)
