1 Corinthians 11

1. 11:17 Because your gatherings do more harm than good
2. 11:18 That when you come together as a church, there are divisions among you
3. 11:19 To show which of you are approved
4. 11:20 For as you eat, each of you goes ahead without sharing his meal
5. 11:23 What I also passed on to you
6. 11:24 "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me."
7. 11:25 "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."
8. 11:26 The Lord's death until He comes
9. 11:27 Whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner

1. 12:1 You to be uninformed about spiritual gifts

3. 12:3 That no one who is speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus be cursed," and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit
4. 12:7 For the common good
5. 12:11 One and the same Spirit, who apportions them to each one as He determines
6. 12:13 We all, whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free
7. 12:15 That would not make it any less a part of the body
8. 12:16 That (And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body")
9. 12:17 Where would the sense of smell be?
10. 12:19 Where would the body be?
11. 12:21 "I do not need you."
