12:1 You to be uninformed about spiritual gifts
2. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 12 verse 2, You know what?
12:2 That when you were pagans, you were influenced and led astray to mute idols
3. Therefore I inform you what?
12:3 That no one who is speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus be cursed," and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit
4. There are different gifts, but who?
12:4 The same Spirit
5. There are different ministries, but who?
12:5 The same Lord
6. Who works all things in all people?
12:6 The same God
7. Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given why?
12:7 For the common good
8. To one there is given through the Spirit the message of what?
12:8 Wisdom
9. To another faith is given how?
12:9 By the same Spirit
10. All these are the work of whom?
12:11 One and the same Spirit, who apportions them to each one as He determines
11. What is a unit, though it is composed of many parts?
12:12 The body
12. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 12 verse 13, Who were all baptized into one body?
12:13 We all, whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free
13. For the body does not consist of one part, but of what?
12:14 Many
14. What if the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body"?
12:15 That would not make it any less a part of the body
15. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 12 verse 16, What would not make it any less a part of the body?
12:16 That (And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body")
16. What if the whole body were an ear?
12:17 Where would the sense of smell be?
17. How has God arranged the members of the body, every one of them?
12:18 According to His design
18. What if they were all one part?
12:19 Where would the body be?
19. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 12 verse 20, What are there?
12:20 Many parts, but one body
20. The eye cannot say to the hand, what?
12:21 "I do not need you."
21. What are indispensable?
12:22 The parts of the body that seem to be weaker
22. And the parts we consider less honorable, we treat how?
12:23 With greater honor
23. Why has God composed the body and has given greater honor to the parts that lacked it?
12:24 So that there should be no division in the body, but that its members should have mutual concern for one another
24. What should have mutual concern for one another?
12:25 Its members
25. What if one part is honored?
12:26 Every part rejoices with it
