1 Corinthians 16

1. Now about the collection for the saints, you are to do as I directed whom?
16:1 The churches of Galatia
2. Why should each of you should set aside a portion of his income, saving it up?
16:2 So that when I come no collections will be needed
3. Then, on my arrival, I will send letters with whom?
16:3 Those you recommend to carry your gift to Jerusalem
4. They can travel with me if what?
16:4 If it is advisable for me to go also
5. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 16 verse 5, When will I come to you?
16:5 After I go through Macedonia
6. Perhaps I will stay with you awhile, or even spend the winter, why?
16:6 So that you can help me on my journey, wherever I go
7. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 16 verse 7, I hope what?
16:7 To spend some time with you, if the Lord permits
8. Why will I stay in Ephesus until Pentecost?
16:8 Because a great door for effective work has opened to me, even though many oppose me
9. What if Timothy comes?
16:10 See to it that he has nothing to fear while he is with you
10. Send him on his way in peace why?
16:11 So that he can return to me, for I am expecting him along with the brothers
11. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 16, Be what?
16:13 On the alert, men of courage, strong
12. Who were the first converts in Achaia?
16:15 Stephanas and his household
13. Why am I glad that Stephanas, Fortunatus, and Achaicus have arrived?
16:17 Because they have supplied what was lacking from you
14. For they refreshed what?
16:18 My spirit and yours as well
15. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 16 verse 19, Who send you greetings?
16:19 The churches in the province of Asia
16. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 16 verse 20, Who send you greetings?
16:20 All the brothers here
17. What if anyone does not love the Lord?
16:22 Let him be under a curse

2 Corinthians 1

1. Who (is) the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort?
1:3 The God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ
2. How can we comfort those in any trouble?
1:4 With the comfort we ourselves have received from God
3. What if we are comforted?
1:6 It is for your comfort, which accomplishes in you patient endurance of the same sufferings we experience
4. ref According to 2 Corinthians chapter 1 verse 7, We know what?
1:7 That just as you share in our sufferings, so also you will share in our comfort
5. We were under a burden far beyond what?
1:8 Our ability to endure
6. We felt we were under the sentence of death, why?
1:9 In order that we would not trust in ourselves, but in God, who raises the dead
7. In Him we have placed what?
1:10 Our hope that He will yet again deliver us
8. Then many will give thanks on our behalf for what?
1:11 The favor shown us in answer to their prayers
9. We have conducted ourselves in the world, and especially in relation to you, in what?
1:12 The holiness and sincerity that are from God
10. ref According to 2 Corinthians chapter 1, I hope what?
1:13 That you will understand completely
11. How may you boast of us?
1:14 Just as we will boast of you in the day of our Lord Jesus
12. Confident of this, I planned to visit you first, why?
1:15 So that you might receive a double blessing
13. Who was not "Yes" and "No," but in Him it has always been "Yes"?
1:19 The Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was proclaimed among you by me and Silvanus and Timothy

14. He anointed us, placed His seal on us, and put His Spirit in our hearts as what?
1:21 A pledge of what is to come
15. Why did I not return to Corinth?
1:23 In order to spare you
16. Why are we fellow workers with you for your joy?
1:24 Because it is by faith that you stand firm

2 Corinthians 2

1. I made up my mind not to make another painful visit to you why?
2:1 For if I grieve you, who is left to cheer me but those whom I have grieved?
2. On my arrival I would not be grieved by whom?
2:3 Those who ought to make me rejoice
3. Through many tears I wrote you out of great distress and anguish of heart, why?
2:4 Not to grieve you but to let you know how much I love you
4. What is sufficient for him?
2:6 The punishment imposed on him by the majority
5. ref According to 2 Corinthians chapter 2 verse 8, I urge you what?
2:8 To reaffirm your love for him
6. What was my purpose in writing you?
2:9 To see if you would stand the test and be obedient in everything
7. What if I have forgiven anything?
2:10 I have forgiven it in the presence of Christ for your sake
8. Why should Satan not outwit us?
2:11 For we are not unaware of his schemes
9. I had no peace in my spirit when?
2:13 When I went to Troas to preach the gospel of Christ and a door stood open for me in the Lord
10. ref According to 2 Corinthians chapter 2, Thanks be to whom?
2:14 God, who always leads us triumphantly as captives in Christ, and through us spreads everywhere the fragrance of the knowledge of Him
11. We are to God the sweet aroma of Christ among whom?
2:15 Those who are being saved and those who are perishing
12. On the contrary, in Christ we speak before God how?
2:17 With sincerity, as men sent from God
