2. My conscience is clear, but that does not vindicate me why?
4:4 It is the Lord who judges me
3. Therefore judge nothing before what?
4:5 The appointed time
4. Why have I applied these things to myself and Apollos for your benefit?
4:6 So that you may learn from us not to go beyond what is written
5. What if you did receive it?
4:7 Why do you boast as though you did not?
6. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 4 verse 8, I wish what?
4:8 You really were kings, so that we might be kings with you
7. How has God displayed us apostles at the end of the procession?
4:9 Like prisoners appointed for death
8. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 4 verse 11, What are we?
4:11 Hungry and thirsty, poorly clothed, brutally treated, homeless
9. We answer gently when?
4:13 When we are slandered
10. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 4 verse 14, I am not writing this to shame you, but to warn you as whom?
4:14 My beloved children
11. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 4 verse 17, Who (is) Timothy?
4:17 My beloved and faithful child in the Lord
12. What if the Lord is willing?
4:19 I will come to you shortly, and then I will find out not only what these arrogant people are saying, but what power they have
13. What is not a matter of talk but of power?
4:20 The kingdom of God

1 Corinthians 5

1. What is actually reported?
5:1 That there is sexual immorality among you, and of a kind that is intolerable even among pagans: A man has his father's wife
2. Hand this man over to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, why?
5:5 So that his spirit may be saved on the day of the Lord
3. Get rid of the old leaven, why?
5:7 That you may be a new unleavened batch, as you really are
4. Let us keep the feast, not with the old bread, leavened with malice and wickedness, but with what?
5:8 The unleavened bread of sincerity and of truth
5. But now I am writing you not to associate with anyone who claims to be a brother but is what?
5:11 Sexually immoral or greedy, an idolater or a verbal abuser, a drunkard or a swindler

1 Corinthians 6

1. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 6 verse 1, What if any of you has a grievance against another?
6:1 How dare he go to law before the unrighteous instead of before the saints!
2. What if you need to settle everyday matters?
6:4 Do you appoint as judges those of no standing in the church
3. The very fact that you have lawsuits among you means what?
6:7 That you are thoroughly defeated already
4. Neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men who submit to or perform homosexual acts, nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor verbal abusers, nor swindlers, will inherit what?
6:9 The kingdom of God
5. How were you sanctified?
6:11 In the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God
6. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 6, What will I not be?
6:12 Mastered by anything
7. "Everything is permissible for me," but not everything is what?
6:12 Beneficial
8. But God will destroy what?
6:13 Them both (Food and the stomach)
9. Who is one with Him in spirit?
6:17 He who unites himself with the Lord

10. Flee from sexual immorality why?
6:18 Every other sin a man can commit is outside his body, but he who sins sexually sins against his own body
11. Your body is a temple of whom?
6:19 The Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have received from God
12. Therefore glorify God how?
6:20 With your body

1 Corinthians 7

1. Why should each man have his own wife?
7:2 Because there is so much sexual immorality
2. Likewise the husband does not have authority over what?
7:4 His own body
3. What if they cannot control themselves?
7:9 Let them marry
4. To the married I give what command?
7:10 This command: A wife must not separate from her husband
5. To the rest I say what?
7:12 This: If a brother has an unbelieving wife and she is willing to live with him, he must not divorce her
6. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 7, What if a woman has an unbelieving husband and he is willing to live with her?
7:13 She must not divorce him
7. Regardless, each one should lead what?
7:17 The life that the Lord has assigned to him and to which God has called him
8. What if you can gain your freedom?
7:21 Take the opportunity
9. Do not become slaves of men why?
7:23 You were bought at a price
10. I give a judgment how?
7:25 As one who by the Lord's mercy is trustworthy
11. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 7 verse 28, I want what?
7:28 To spare you this (Those who marry will face troubles in this life)
12. Those who make a purchase should live how?
7:30 As if they had nothing
13. What is passing away?
7:31 This world in its present form
14. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 7 verse 32, I want what?
7:32 You to be free from concern
15. I am saying this for your own good, not to restrict you, but in order to promote what?
7:35 Proper decorum and undivided devotion to the Lord
