2. I always thank my God for you why?  
1:4 Because of the grace He has given you in Christ Jesus
3. For in Him you have been enriched in what way?  
1:5 Every way, in all speech and all knowledge
4. What was confirmed in you?  
1:6 Our testimony about Christ
5. Therefore you do not lack any spiritual gift as you eagerly await what?  
1:7 The revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ
6. He will sustain you to what?  
1:8 The end
7. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 1 verse 8, What will you be?  
1:8 Blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ
8. God has called you into fellowship with whom?  
1:9 His Son Jesus Christ our Lord
9. I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that what?  
1:10 All of you agree together
10. My brothers, some from Chloe's household have informed me that what?  
1:11 There are quarrels among you
11. Individuals among you are saying, what?  
1:12 "I follow Paul," "I follow Apollos," "I follow Cephas," or "I follow Christ."
12. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 1 verse 14, I thank God that I did not baptize whom?  
1:14 Any of you except Crispus and Gaius
13. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 1 verse 15, What can no one say?  
1:15 That you were baptized into my name
14. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 1 verse 18, What is the power of God to us who are being saved?  
1:18 It (The message of the cross)
15. Whose intelligence will I frustrate?  
1:19 The intelligence of the intelligent
16. Why was God pleased through the foolishness of what was preached to save those who believe?  
1:21 Since in the wisdom of God, the world through its wisdom did not know Him
17. Jews demand signs and Greeks search for what?  
1:22 Wisdom
18. But to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ (is) what?  
1:24 The power of God and the wisdom of God
19. What is stronger than man's strength?  
1:25 The weakness of God
20. God chose the weak things of the world to shame whom?  
1:27 The strong
21. Who has become for us wisdom from God: our righteousness, holiness, and redemption?  
1:30 Christ Jesus
22. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 1 verse 31, What is written?  
1:31 "Let him who boasts boast in the Lord."

## 1 Corinthians 2

1. For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except whom?  
2:2 Jesus Christ and Him crucified
2. Why were my message and my preaching not with persuasive words of wisdom, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power?  
2:4 So that your faith would not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power
3. He destined what for our glory before time began?  
2:7 The mysterious and hidden wisdom of God
4. What if they had understood it?  
2:8 They would not have crucified the Lord of glory
5. ref According to 1 Corinthians chapter 2 verse 9, What is written?

3:4 "I follow Apollos"
4. So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only who?  
3:7 God, who makes things grow
5. How will each be rewarded?  
3:8 According to his own labor
6. By the grace God has given me, I laid a foundation as what?  
3:10 An expert builder
7. What if anyone builds on this foundation using gold, silver, precious stones,  
wood, hay, or straw?  
3:12 His workmanship will be evident, because the Day will bring it to  
light
8. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will prove what?  
3:13 The quality of each man's work
9. What if it is burned up?  
3:15 He will suffer loss
10. If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him why?  
3:17 For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple

3:22 All of them (All things, whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas or the  
world or life or death or the present or the future)
